

1893 CALCUTTA BOAT RACE

WORCESTER BOAT CREW:

1. **COX:** **Charles Edward PALMER (1891 - 1891)**
d.o.b. 22 July 1875 in Cambridge,
Son of C.W. PALMER of Cambridge, a solicitor who was Coroner for Cambridge,
Educated at Cambridge Grammar School prior to joining the Worcester in the Lent term of 1891 (28?) January 1891.
He left sometime in the Lent term of 1891 to join T & J Brocklebank to serve his apprenticeship.

2. **STROKE:** **William HIGHFIELD (1888 - 89)**
d.o.b. 24 June 1872 in Blencogo, Cumberland,
Son of George HIGHFIELD, occupation not known,
Educated at Tonbridge Grammar School, Kent, prior to joining the Worcester in the Lent term of 1888 (23 January 1888),
He left in the Michaelmas term of 1889 (23 December 1889) to join T & J Brocklebank to serve his apprenticeship.

3. **Arundel Francis Robert Irvine NEAVE (1890 - 92)**
d.o.b. 01 September 1874 in Lymington, Hampshire,
Son of Richard Irvine NEAVE, a Gentleman of Lymington, Hampshire,
Educated at Dorset County School, Dorchester, prior to joining the Worcester in the Easter term of 1890 (01 May 1890),
He left in the Lent term of 1892 (11 April 1892) to join Goffey & Co. of Liverpool.

4. **Francis Maude ROXBY (1890 - 92)**
d.o.b. 30 May 1876 in Buckden, Huntingdon,
Son of the Reverend ROXBY, vicar of Buckden, Huntingdon,
Educated at Lynewode Rectory, Market Rasen, prior to joining the Worcester in the Lent term of 1890 (27 January 1890),
He left in the Lent term of 1892 (11 April 1892) to join Goffey & Co of Liverpool.

5. & 6. **James Bruce BARLOW, or Arthur Eustace BARLOW (1888 - 91)**
d.o.b. 21 March 1873 and 09 April 1874, both in Bathampton, Bath,
The sons of O.J. BARLOW, postmaster of Bath,
Both sons educated at Bath College, prior to joining the Worcester in the Easter term of 1888 (12 April 1888),
They both left the ship in the Easter term of 1891 (31 July 1891).
