Data protection policy

1. AOW data protection Policy.

- 1.1 For the purposes of this document, the Terms "Association" "Association of Old Worcesters" or "AOW" includes the Old Worcesters Yacht Club (OWYC)...
- 1.2 This policy explains when and why AOW collects personal information about its members, how it uses it and how it is kept secure and your rights in relation to it.
- 1.3 AOW will collect, use and store your personal data as described in this Data Processing Policy and as described when data is collected from you.
- 1.4 AOW reserves the right to amend this Data Protection Policy from time to time without prior notice. You are advised to check the AOW website at www.hms-worcester.org.uk regularly for any amendments. Amendments will never be made retrospectively.
- 1.5 AOW will always comply fully with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) when dealing with your personal data.
 Further details of the GDPR can be found here.
 For the purposes of the GDPR AOW will be the "controller" of all personal data held on you.
- 1.6 AOW will not hold any data termed as "Special Category Data" (previously known as "sensitive data") under the terms of the Regulations.

2. Protection of personal data.

2.1 AOW will not transfer your personal data to any third party without your consent.

- 2.2 AOW has implemented generally accepted standards of technology and operational security in order to protect your personal data from loss, misuse, or unauthorised alteration or destruction. Members will be notified promptly in the event of any breach of your personal data which might expose you to serious risk.
- 2.3 Members should note that any information transmitted to AOW over the internet can never be guaranteed to be 100% secure.

3. Retention of information.

- 3.1 AOW will retain your personal data on its systems for as long as you are a member of the club and for as long afterwards as is necessary to comply with our legal obligations.
- 3.2 Your data will be reviewed annually to establish whether AOW is still entitled to process it. If it is established that such entitlement no longer exists, your data will no longer be processed except that your personal data will be retained in an archive form in order to be able to comply with any future legal obligations.
- 3.3 Archived information will be retained in perpetuity as it forms part of the definitive Historical Record of the Thames Nautical Training College, HMS Worcester. As such, archived material may be made available to third parties where the Association considers the recipient has a valid reason for requesting it.
- 3.4 Information released by the Association under the terms of Para 3.3 above will not include any information relevant to living members of the Association without their express written permission.

Members may withdraw their consent at any time by contacting the Data Protection Officer by email or letter.

Date of Birth/Death, Full details as included in the "Worcester Register"	To maintain the official Historical Record of the College.	As the official record of the college may be accessed by third parties with a legitimate reason for accessing the information held. Information on "Live" members will not be released without prior consent obtained on a case by case basis

5. Your rights.

 - c. To have your personal data corrected.
 - d. To have your personal data erased in certain circumstances
 - e. To object or restrict how your personal data is processed.
 - f. To have your personal data transferred to yourself or to another business or organisation in certain circumstances.
